Thank you for downloading my week in Charleston itinerary. You are going to have so much fun! Charleston holds so much history and it's so beautiful.

My Custom Map

It will open in Google maps. Sign into your Google Account and make sure it is saved under your maps. After doing this, you will be able to pull it up in the Google Maps app on your phone (as long as you are signed into the same Google Account).

You will notice the markers on the map are color coded:

- **Black:** The hotel I stayed in. If you aren't staying in the same hotel I stayed in, ignore that marker.
- **Dark Red:** Tours
- **Dark Blue:** Museums & Plantations
- **Purple:** Parks, Things to see, and Market
- **Yellow:** Churches
- **Coral:** Restaurants and Dessert Shops
- **Blue:** "Second Choice" Museums and Landmarks
- **Dark Green:** "Second Choice" Restaurants

To get to the map on your phone open Google Maps, tap saved, tap maps, you will see it there titled Charleston Tap Charleston and the map with all the markers will open. Tap any marker you want to go to and click directions.

My Itinerary

Remember, it is color coded for you too. **Purple** tells you what times the places open and close, **blue** tells you addresses you will need, **green** tells you the prices of things, and **red** tells you important things to know.

Also, remember it is editable to you. If there is something on it you'd like to change, do it!

A few important things to know before you go:

- Hotel Emeline is in a great location

It is close to everything. It's right next to the Historic Market, and it is within walking distance to many places you will be visiting. If you book directly with them by clicking the link in the itinerary you will get a free drink when you arrive.

- You can easily stretch this itinerary out to 7 days

My family and I did it in 5 days. It was a very busy 5 days, each day we were up early and we were going nonstop all day. If you want a little more down time or to spend more time on the beach, stretch this into a 7 day itinerary. Folly Beach and Sullivans Island Beach are the two most popular ones.

- If you don't want to go to plantations, visit other houses and museums instead

You can easily take a trip to Charleston and not visit any plantations. There is so much to do here! Look at my custom map under the "second choice" museums and landmarks. Replace the plantations with things from that list.
